THE COURT ORDERS you, the young person, to serve,

- (b) to report to the provincial director and then be under the supervision of the provincial director;
- (c) to inform the provincial director immediately on being arrested or questioned by the police;

- (e) to advise the provincial director of the young person's current address of residence and report immediately to the probation officer any:
 - (i) change in the address,
 - (ii) change in normal occupation, employment, vocational or educational training or volunteer work,
 - (iii) change in family or financial situation, and
 - (iv) change that may reasonable expected to affect the ability to comply with the conditions of the sentence;
- (f) not to own, possess or have the control of any weapon, ammunition, prohibited ammunition, prohibited device or explosive substance, except as authorized in writing by the provincial director for the purpose of participating in a program specified in the authorization.

(Extract from Section 42(4) YCJA)

You are ordered to serve _____ (state the number of days or months to be served) in custody, to be followed by _____ (state one-half of the number of days or months stated above) to be served under supervision in the community subject to conditions.

If you breach any of the conditions while you are under supervision in the community, you may be brought back into custody and required to serve the rest of the second period in custody as well.

You should also be aware that, under other provisions of the Youth Criminal Justice Act, a court could require you to serve the second period in custody as well.

The periods in custody and under supervision in the community may be changed if you are or become subject to another sentence.
