**SECTION 259(4) OF THE CRIMINAL CODE OF CANADA STATES AS FOLLOWS:**

**Everyone who operates a motor vehicle, vessel, or aircraft or any railway equipment in Canada while disqualified from doing so**

- (a) is guilty of an indictable offence and liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding five years; or**
- (b) is guilty of an offence punishable on summary conviction.**
