NOTICE OF DISCONTINUANCE OF A CIVIL APPEAL BEFORE THE NOVA SCOTIA COURT OF APPEAL

1. Read the attached Notice of Discontinuance Form 9.02 carefully and retype the Notice of Discontinuance with your own information making the following specific changes to the form: a) replace Supreme Court of Nova Scotia with **Nova Scotia Court of Appeal**, and b) replace the words discontinues this proceeding in the first sentence with **discontinues this appeal**.
2. Civil Procedure Rule 90 applies to all civil appeals before the Nova Scotia Court of Appeal - review the rule on the courts website at: www.courts.ns.ca
3. You must file an original and two (2) copies of your Notice of Discontinuance with the Registrar of the Court if you do not wish to continue with your appeal before the Court of Appeal.
4. You must sign the Notice of Discontinuance.
5. You must provide a copy of the Notice of Discontinuance to each Respondent on the appeal.
6. You must also send a copy of the Notice of Discontinuance to the judge from whose judgment the appeal is brought.
