

JURY SELECTION PROCESS 2021

The Nova Scotia Supreme Court has adopted measures that help to minimize the spread of the COVID-19 virus. These measures follow the advice of public health officials as part of the safe services model of the Court. We understand it can be stressful to attend public places during the pandemic. We want you to feel safe.

What you can expect from us:

Managed pedestrian flow in public areas to reduce congestion,
Signs posted and direction provided by sheriff's officers and court staff,
Provision of disposable medical masks to be worn in the courthouse as directed,
Regular cleaning of frequently touched surfaces, and
Additional places for hand sanitizing.

What we ask of you during the jury selection process:

Wash your hands with soap and water when you can, sanitize your hands regularly when you are unable to do so.

Maintain appropriate physical distancing when speaking to someone.

Follow instructions posted on signs and listen to the direction provided by sheriff's officers and court staff. This is to keep you safe.

Please wear the disposable medical mask provided to you by the sheriff and ask for a replacement mask if the one provided becomes damp, soiled or damaged.

Keep personal items to a minimum to prevent delays through security screening. Avoid bringing metal objects.
