

JURY SELECTION PROCESS

The Nova Scotia Supreme Court has introduced preventative measures that will help minimize the spread of the COVID-19 virus. These measures follow the advice of public health officials. We understand it can be stressful to attend public places during the pandemic. We want you to feel safe.

What you can expect from us:

Enforced physical distancing at all times,
Managed pedestrian flow in public areas to reduce congestion,
Signs posted and direction provided by sheriff's officers and court staff,
Face masks must be worn - please bring one or one will be provided to you,
Regular cleaning of frequently touched surfaces, and
Additional places for hand sanitizing stations.

What we ask of you during the jury selection process:

Do not come if you are unwell and please call to advise the Jury Coordinator.
Wash your hands with soap and water when you can and disinfect your hands regularly when you are unable to wash them.
Maintain appropriate physical distancing when speaking to someone and follow the cough and sneeze etiquette.
Follow instructions posted on signs and listen to the direction provided by sheriff's officers and court staff. This is to keep you safe.
Please bring your own non-medical mask (personal face mask).
Keep personal items to a minimum to prevent delays through security screening.
Avoid bringing metal objects.
