NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ACT ON ONE'S OWN IN THE SUPREME COURT OF NOVA SCOTIA

- 1. A party who discharges their lawyer and wishes to act on their own must attend the prothonotary's office to file a Notice of Intention to Act on One's Own (Form 33.07).
- 2. This document must be filed by the party in person, unless the party has obtained written permission from the prothonotary directing that a personal attendance is not required.
- **3.** Read the attached Notice of Intention to Act on One's Own (Form 33.07). Retype or add in the following information to the form:
 - The year the appeal was started in the top left hand corner
 - The court file number in the top right hand corner
 - The names of the parties
 - The details in the following sections:
 - Discharge of counsel
 - Acting on own, and
 - Contacting prothonotary
 - Your contact information and designated address for delivery of documents.
 - Date and sign the form
- **4.** The Court will keep one copy of this document for filing, and you will need to provide one copy for each party and one for your former counsel.
- 5. You must immediately deliver a court stamped copy of the notice to your former counsel, and to each party entitled to notice in the proceeding.
- **6.** There is no filing fee for this document.
