



COURTHOUSE IN SHELBURNE TEMPORARILY CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC FOR MAINTENANCE

Counsel and members of the public are advised that the Shelburne courthouse, located inside the Shelburne Municipal Building at 136 Hammond St., will be temporarily closed to the public to facilitate maintenance. This work is expected to continue until at least Monday, Sept. 12, 2022.

During the closure, there will be no front counter services available. Anyone who wants to pay a summary offence ticket or other fine can do so online at <https://beta.novascotia.ca/pay-fine-ticket> or by mailing a cheque or money order to the appropriate level of court.

The Shelburne Provincial and Supreme Courts will continue to hear matters virtually by telephone and videoconferencing, as needed, from the courthouse in Yarmouth.
