



UNDERGROUND PARKING LOT AT THE LAW COURTS CLOSED

Counsel and visitors to the Halifax Law Courts building at 1815 Upper Water Street are advised that until further notice, for safety reasons, the parking garage is closed to all vehicles. This includes the daily and monthly parking areas, as well as the secure staff entrances in those areas.

The street-level entrances to the parkade have been blocked and attendants will be on hand this week to redirect anyone who tries to enter or park their vehicle.

Daily and monthly parking are available at Scotia Square, Queen's Marque and Purdy's Wharf, as well as on-street paid parking.

Counsel and visitors must use the main entrance. Visitors with accessibility concerns can bypass the stairs at the main entrance by using the pedestrian bridge near the corner of George and Upper Water Streets.

The Courts regret any inconvenience this closure may cause. Further updates on parking at the Law Courts will be provided via additional court notices.
